**Evangelistic Medical Mission Crusades (EMMC)** are weeklong crusades, complete with doctors, dentists, hair stylists, children's workers, cooks and general volunteers that seek to meet the physical needs present in poverty-stricken regions throughout Mexico in order to more effectively address the spiritual needs of the people. The Good News of Jesus Christ is shared individually with each person that attends the crusade. Fishers of Men works closely with local churches and missionaries to ensure the follow-up and discipleship of the new believers.



**Refuge Ranch** is Victor and Julie's home in central Mexico where they welcome in children in need of a forever family. As part of a loving Christian family, the children find the love, nurture, freedom and structure necessary to become all that God wants them to be.
